FAQs | Induction Programme 2018

Q. What is Induction Program?

Ans. The main goal of the induction program is to help students shift plane from school to University (Institute) life. Specifically, we hope that at the end of the program, students are committed and excited about learning, and appreciate that learning is crucial for their career and future as well as personal growth. This program will also help students to appreciate the importance of professionalism and value. At the same time it will help them establishing a healthy bonding within the student community.

Q. What is the duration of induction programme?

Ans. This year the induction programme will be organised from 24th July to 31st July 2018.

Q. When do I need to report for the Induction programme?

Ans. The registrations for induction will be done from 8-9 AM on 24th July. The registrations will take place on the ground floor of the seminar hall. So, do reach on time.

Q. What are the documents needed for the registration during induction?

Ans. You just need to bring the acknowledgement letter/receipt/admission letter you got from the institute during counselling.

Q. Any pre-requisite for the Induction program?

Ans. No, activities are planned in such a way that a student will get to know about everything from very basics. You need not worry for pre-knowledge of any programming language or any skills beforehand.

Q. Can I opt-out of some activities and attend rest of the activities planned in induction?

Ans. No, activities are planned in such a way that a student will get to know about everything that we do here at IIITD.Believe me all the activities will be fun:)

Q. My parents want to attend the whole induction with me. Can they?

Ans. Sessions in the induction are planned exclusively for the students. But there is a session with parents also on Saturday they can attend the same.

Q. What about food?

Ans. Food facilities would be available in mess as well as canteen. You have to pay for the food during the week of induction, separate payment for each meal. Afterwards, mess coupons would be available from the month of August. You could buy 20,25 or 30 day coupons whose price are fixed.

Q. Will I get a mattress?

Ans. Mattress won't be provided as of now, will be available on rent-we are arranging vendor at the institute to provide, preferably to bring along a mattress with you. Outside delhi students are expected to get their own mattress as it will be needed throughout the hostel life.

Tip: A stuffy blanket will do the job for a week. No need to buy a mattress for induction period only.

Q. Will I be getting a hostel room for the induction? If Yes, What will be the fees for the stay?

Ans. Yes, you will be getting a hostel for the induction period. Hostel accommodation will be available from 22nd July for outside Delhi students and from 23rd for Delhi students. Hostel during the induction will be free,i.e. No fee:)

Q. I want a hostel room, What is the distance cutoff for that ?

Ans. Distance cutoff will be totally dependent on the availability of rooms and the kind of students who are applying for Hostel.

Q. When can i apply for hostel room? Can I apply for single room(No sharing)?

Ans. You can apply for the hostel during induction and will get a confirmation in the following week or the next week. Single rooms aren't available for students in their 1st year.

Q. When to pay the remaining semester fee and hostel fee?

Ans. You will be receiving emails for every such activity in IIITD. It would be probably from 23-30 July 2018. Keep visiting IIITD and JAC website for details.

Q. Is it compulsory to stay at hostel during induction?

Ans. No, its not compulsory to stay at hostel during the induction.But you'll miss the fun of night activities so it's advised to stay at the hostel even if you live just 5 mins away from the college:

Q. Is it necessary to bring a laptop for programming sessions or otherwise?

Ans. This is completely a personal choice. If you have a laptop and want to work on that, it's better to bring. It will be appreciated if you bring your laptop if you have one,otherwise there is no compulsion.

Q. What about the access of WiFi? What is the username and password?

Ans. Wifi is available for both laptops and mobile and a temporary username and password will be given to you on the first day of induction itself. If you arrive early in hostels(option available only for outside Delhi Students), please contact any of the coordinators (contact details mentioned on the website) and get the WiFi details.

Q. Which is the nearest metro station?

Ans. There are 2 metro lines near IIITD campus.

The violet line with Govindpuri Metro Station and Okhla Metro Station.Both close to campus. Govind Puri Metro Station would offer a 5-7 minute auto-rickshaw distance(recommended for students with luggage) or 12-15 minute walking distance. On the other hand, Okhla metro stations offers only walking distance of around 5-7 minutes.(The gates are open till 8pm only and the route shall be avoided if you are alone)

NSIC Okhla metro station on the newly constructed magenta line offers a comparatively longer walk to college but prefered for students coming from Dwarka or Noida side as you need not change at Kalkaji Metro for violet line and this saves few minutes. Auto-rickshaw service is very good but not a recommended path after dawn.

Q. What things one should bring for Induction Programme?

Ans. For day scholars :-

Back your backs with Notebooks and Pens. Bring along a water bottle and light snacks. In case, you wish to attend some particular night-event, bring a pair of clothes with you and ask any of the coordinator there for room for a night.

For Outside Delhi students:- As you would all be shifting to the hostel on a permanent basis and not just for induction, so you should must have your own single bed mattress which won't be provided by the hostel. Rest of the things are totally dependent on your own needs. Bring your daily life things. There will be availability of microwave oven in the common room of hostels, otherwise no electrical equipments are allowed in the hostel rooms.

For delhi students -- You, depending on the distance, may or may not get the hostel rooms for this academic session. I will suggest you to pack light for the induction week and shift the whole stuff after you get the room. Take it as a week long tour. Pack accordingly.

Q. Is there any market nearby to buy all the things we need for the hostel stay?

Ans. There is KALKAJI MARKET just 2 kms away. You can buys almost everything here. NEHRU PLACE is also very close in case u need any electronics item. Just google the shops here and you can easily use ola/uber to carry the things in case they are not easily portable.

Q. Is there a shop within campus to cater the daily need in Hostel?

Ans. Yes, a all-in-one shop is located in the student center near the canteen and incubation centre. The timings are 10am to 9pm. You can get things like basic stationery, soap, snacks, mosquito repellant etc. from the shop.

Q. My parents wish to know if there is any guest room available for both induction and during semesters ?

Ans. As per now, there are two guest rooms available for stay at 1500/- per day. You need to have a pre booking if your parents/relatives want to stay in campus for a day or two! The number of rooms and price, once fix for this year, will be told to you during induction program. For guest room booking one should write to arunv@iiitd.ac.in (Mr. Arun Verma GM. Operations)
