<p>As per point 2, NABET (QCI) Accreditation is required for preparation of EIA/EMP Reports and not for environmental monitoring and preparation of compliance reports. Environmental monitoring is to be done by a laboratory, which should be MoEF&CC Recognised or NABL Accredited. NABET does not accredit laboratories</p>	<p>Pt 2 as amended: -- The NABET accreditation would be preferable. Firms with such accreditation will be given more weightage.</p>
<p>As per point 3, If the Consultancy is NABET accredited, this does not imply that the consultancy also has a NABL/MoEF Accredited laboratory</p>	<p>Pt 3 as amended: -- The NABL accredited lab could be in house/empanelled/Group Company's. Firms with in house NABL accredited labs would be given more weightage</p>
<p>As per point 7, you have asked for 15 numbers of assignments, which is quiet large. Generally 3-5 works are required to be submitted in the tender of specially Govt./public sector/educational institutions</p>	<p>Pt 7 as amended:-- 8-10 nos assignments of which 4-5 are preferably required to be with Govt./public sector/educational institutions</p>
<p>As per Point 8, states "any running and completed Environmental assignment by the firm operational educational project on a land area more than or equal to 25 acres". The area of the project has no bearing on environmental monitoring</p>	<p>Pt 8 as amended:-- Land area is mentioned as per our site area. The stipulation of area more than or equal to 25 acres is withdrawn. Rest remains same</p>
