Opine Feedback Session 13th Aug, 11AM to 12:30PM

The IQAC session was conducted to discuss and propose measures to address the concerns related to negative/offensive comments. During the session, following points were discussed-

Educating the students: IIT-K used to conduct anti-cyberbullying sessions in the past.
IQAC is seeking the format of this module. Once the details are available, further planning on how to appropriately conduct the session will be initiated.

There are external agencies which conduct anti-cyberbullying sessions and may be explored in future.

- One of the immediate action points is to decouple the objective and subjective components of the opine feedback form. The objective part will be augmented with questions that shall address some of the known concerns with respect to syllabus and conduct of classes. The subjective part can be made optional and will not be collected if not desired.
- In the current feedback system, any student in possession of link can fill the form. As such, the students who are not supposed to fill (caught in plagiarism/students of other classes) can illegitimately fill the form without being detected. This security flaw will be revisited by Byld team.
