

RULES AND PROCEDURE FOR SPOT ROUND Admission M.Tech. (CB) 2020-21 Admission process through GAT-B

Spot round admissions will be conducted online on November 20, 2020 to fill the vacant seats (if any) in M.Tech. (CB) GAT-B process.

The eligibility and application process etc. are given below:

1. <u>Vacancy position:</u>

2. Who are eligible to participate in spot round

The candidates who are on Merit List of Candidates for M.Tech. (CB)- through GAT-B Admission process and out of those candidates following candidates are eligible to apply for spot round;

- i) The registered candidates in merit list who have not been offered any seat up to 2nd Round.
- ii) The candidates who accepted the admission offer and have later withdrawn their admission at any stage.
- iii) The candidates who have been allotted a seat in some round but did not accept the offer of admission.

Note: Candidates who have already accepted the offer of admission and not taken withdrawal are **NOT** allowed to participate in spot round.

3. <u>Procedure for spot round</u>

The above-mentioned eligible candidates have to follow the following steps in order to participate in spot round:

Candidates have to submit their willingness for participation by 19th July 2020, 05:00
PM by filling this FORM. On submission of the this form the candidate will get an Email of their response filled. This will give a confirmation to the candidate that his/her response has been submitted successfully.

- Candidates will be called in rank wise order online over google meet on the day of spot round (i.e. 20th November 2020) and will be offered admission from the available vacant seats.
- iii) Google meet link and schedule will be informed to the registered and eligible candidates on 20th November 2020, 10 AM. Candidates are advised to check the registered email on regular basis. In case you don't get an Email by 10 AM, you may contact Adminadmissions on 011-26907417
- iv) If a candidate is called and s/he chooses a seat and the seat is offered to him/her, then it will be announced for the information of all and the same seat will be deducted from the vacancy. Vacancy list will be presented during google meet session for instant verification of vacancy position by other candidates during the spot round.
- v) <u>The candidate who accepts the admission offer in spot round</u> need to pay the fee i.e. Rs.52,000/- online here <u>https://payments.iiitd.edu.in/pg/fees/pg.html</u>. Hence, all candidates are advised to ready with the payment.
- vi) <u>The candidate who accepts the offer in spot round</u> will forward the receipt from his/her registered email id to <u>mtech-admissions@iiitd.ac.in</u>. Only after the payment of fee and submission of receipt the seat will be confirmed.
- vii) The process will go on till the seats are exhausted or there are no candidates available for offer of admission.

4. Important Note:

- i) The Institute reserves the right to change the spot round process. The Institute also reserves the right to fill the seats fully or partially at its own discretion without assigning any reasons thereof.
- Candidate need to ensure Good internet speed, that supports a video call, with possibly negligible interruptions/ drop-outs. Do test your internet connection before the day of the spot round so that you can be certain that it is working.
- iii) Be available for the spot round in a room where you are alone so that you are not disturbed.
- iv) Do make sure the lighting in the room is good and make sure whatever is behind you is simple and appropriate.
- v) Do set the camera up so that you are seen from the waist up.
- vi) Institute will not be held responsible for failure of any internet connection during the online spot round seat allocation process. And if during the announcement of rank s/he is not available, the process will be moved to the next ranked candidates.
