Subject: Scholarship Schemes of IIIT-Delhi

In supersession to the Office Order No. 23/2024, Dated 19 April 2024, the Board of Governors, in its 66th meeting, has approved the following recommendations of the Scholarship Committee, to be implemented from the AY 2023-24.

1. Chairman's Scholarship Schemes: *[no change]*

- (a) Students with JEE main rank below 1000 will be awarded a scholarship equivalent to 100% of the tuition fees.
- (b) Students with JEE main rank between 1000-2000 will be awarded a scholarship equivalent to 50% of the tuition fees.

2. Women Empowerment Scholarship in STEAM Education (WESSE) Scheme: *[no change]*

Top 100 female students who scored more than 95% aggregate marks in the class XIIth Board Exam, and were admitted to IIIT-Delhi in any B.Tech. program will be granted the above scholarship equivalent to 50% of the tuition fee provided the candidate is not eligible to get any other scholarship from a Government source. If a candidate is eligible to get any other scholarship from a Government source, they must apply for the same, the Institute shall be committed to covering only the remainder scholarship.

For above two scholarships (Chairman's and WESSE Schemes), the students who will get the scholarship in the first year and will be eligible to get these scholarships for the next 4 years as well, provided if he/she maintains the below-mentioned criteria:

- Maintain a CGPA of 7.5
- May have a maximum of 1 F grade (in two semesters, in an academic year)
- They should not have a Plagiarism case.
- If a student cannot complete the degree requirements in 4 years, he/she will not get this scholarship in the extended semesters.
- During Semester leave the Scholarship will not be applicable, however the students will be eligible for total of 8 active semesters.



3. IIIT-Delhi Merit cum Means Scholarship: *[1st year included; CGPA & Scope of Scholarship updated]*

The scheme has been revised with a scope to award 100% scholarship to the students meeting the following eligibility criteria;

- Students in their 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th years will be eligible for this scholarship.
- Beneficiary under National Food Security Scheme or Below Poverty Line (BPL) & possess the Card issued under the Scheme.
- Except first year, students from all other years should have a CGPA of 7.0 or above with a maximum 1 F grade (in their last two semesters) and not have a plagiarism case.

The application process and timeline will be follows:

1. Fresh applications will be invited each year. Every year, a student has to apply afresh.
2. The applications will be submitted after the fee payment deadline for both the Monsoon and Winter Semesters.
3. The process will be closed within the financial year.

The selection process will be as follows:

The details and documents submitted by the student will be verified and the scholarship will be awarded after due approval of competent authority.

While applying, the student has to submit an Affidavit-Cum-Undertaking with the following two statements: (To be executed on non-judicial stamp paper of Rs. 100/- duly attested by the Executive Magistrate or Notary Public)

1. The student does not receive a scholarship from any other private or government source.
2. In case the student receives any scholarship from other source after the award of scholarship, they will refund the same to IIIT-Delhi.

This is issued with the approval of the Competent Authority.
