

Regulations for Minor in Human Centered Design

Minor Program:

A BTech student can earn a minor certification in HCD by completing 12 credits of regular courses, and further 8 credits through additional coursework or 8 credits of BTP registered under Design track, with prior approval by HCD UG Coordinator, for a cumulative 20 credits in HCD. The program is intended to be complementary to CSE/ECE/CSAM/CSB/CSSS.

Students pursuing BTech in CSD cannot opt for a Minor in Human Centered Design.

Courses: All courses are for 4 credits

- 1. Mandatory 12 Credits Any 3 DES-numbered (2xx to 6xx) course as long as prerequisites are fulfilled.
- 2. Remaining 8 **Credits**: There are 2 options in the minor program

The minor program is designed to provide students with a basic training in design thinking processes and perspectives along with some in-depth understanding of emerging interaction design technologies.

Other courses will be added to this basket on the recommendation of the HCD faculty. The request to add a new course will be forwarded to AAC. The AAC will be empowered to add a new course.

Sequencing:

Most of the courses can be taken by the students during /after their 2^{nd} year. BTP can be done during the $3^{rd}/4^{th}$ year.
