Guidelines for Parents of B.Tech Students

(Supporting Your Ward at IIIT-Delhi)

Dear Parents,

We warmly welcome you to the IIIT-Delhi community. We understand that the transition from school to university can be a big step for both students and parents. At IIIT-Delhi, our philosophy is to help students grow as independent, responsible young adults while ensuring that parents feel informed and assured about their ward's progress.

This guide explains how you can stay connected, where to find important information, and how to reach us if you have any concerns.

1. Our Approach and Common Terminologies

Our Approach

- University life is very different from school: students are treated as young adults and are encouraged to take charge of their studies and well-being.
- Faculty and staff are here to guide and support, but we encourage students to reach out themselves whenever they face challenges.
- Parents play an important role by maintaining regular communication with their ward and encouraging them to seek help whenever needed.
- We request parents to ensure that their phone numbers and addresses are always updated in the institute records. This helps us contact you promptly if there is ever an important concern or urgent matter regarding your ward.

Common Terminologies

To help parents understand some of the academic terms frequently used at the university:

• **Transcript:** An official record of a student's courses, grades, SGPA and CGPA across semesters. It is like a consolidated report card.

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- **Grade:** A letter assigned to a student in a course that reflects their performance, corresponding to a numerical grade point used in SGPA and CGPA calculations. (https://www.iiitd.ac.in/academics/resources/evaluation)
- SGPA (Semester Grade Point Average): The credit-weighted average of a student's grades for all courses taken in a semester, calculated using the formula: SGPA = (Σ (Credit × Grade Point)) / (Σ Credits)
- CGPA (Cumulative Grade Point Average): A number (out of 10) that reflects a student's overall academic performance across all semesters.
- **Semester:** A 16–18 week academic term. IIIT-Delhi runs two main semesters each year *Monsoon (Aug–Dec)* and *Winter (Jan–May)*.
- **Credits:** Each course has a credit value that reflects the workload. Students must complete a certain number of credits to graduate.
- **ERP** (Enterprise Resource Planning Portal): The online system where students can see attendance, results, fee details, course registrations, etc.
- **Backlog:** A course that a student could not clear in an earlier attempt and may need to reattempt in the future. IIIT-Delhi does not have the provision of supplementary exams to clear a course.
- **Advisors/Mentors:** Faculty members assigned to guide students academically and personally during their time at the institute.

2. Academic Progress

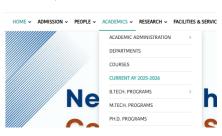
- **Results & Grades:** All academic results (course grades, semester results) are shared with students through the ERP system. Parents can ask their ward to show these results to stay updated.
- **Timetables & Calendars:** Exam schedules, semester calendars, and announcements are regularly posted on the institute website. Results are announced tentatively 3 weeks after the completion of the end-of-semester examination and shared via email.
- Attendance & Concerns: Attendance requirements vary from course to course, and we do not keep daily attendance records of students. If there are any serious concerns about a student's performance, the institute may reach out directly to both the student and the parents.

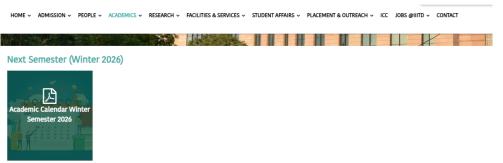

Current Semester (Monsoon 2025)











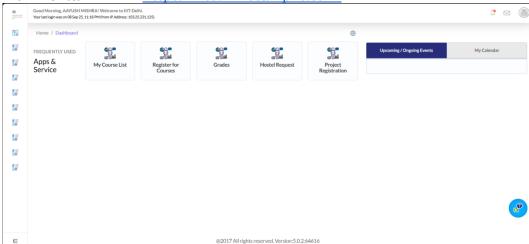
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4. ERP – Student Information Portal for Transcript

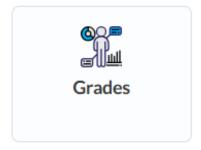
The **ERP** (Enterprise Resource Planning) system is the central online portal where students can view all their academic information. Parents do not have separate logins, but with their ward's help, they can access course registration details for each semester and final results via the transcript. The transcript is updated only after the results are officially declared.

Please follow the steps below to view the transcript:

- a. Using the above link, login to the ERP system of IIITD
- b. Click on "Grades"



c. Click on the loor on the top right of the page





You can then proceed to download the transcript.

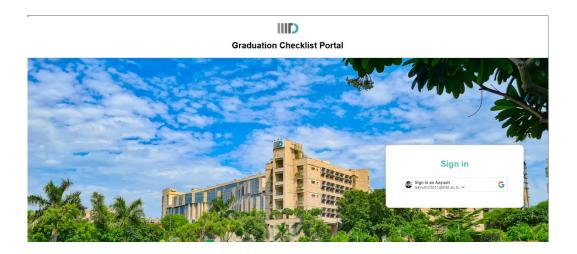
- In case parents wish to seek an appointment with the Dean of Academic Affairs, UG Chair, or PG Chair, please write an email to the Academic Office requesting approval.

10. Graduation Portal Check

The **Graduation Check Portal** is an online tool available on the IIIT-Delhi network (accessible through campus Wi-Fi or via VPN). It allows students to track their progress toward graduation based on the regulations of their program.



Through this portal, students can:

- View the **requirements they have already fulfilled** (courses and credits completed).
- See the **requirements still pending** (courses or categories yet to be completed).
- Know **how many credits are left** and in which areas (core, electives, etc.).
- Access an updated summary after every semester's results are declared.

This portal is especially useful for **3rd and 4th-year students**, as it helps them plan their remaining courses and credits efficiently to ensure timely graduation.

Note: The Graduation Check Portal is currently in the *testing phase*. Students are advised to use it as a helpful guide, but final confirmation of graduation requirements will be done by the **Academic Affairs Office** after proper verification.
