



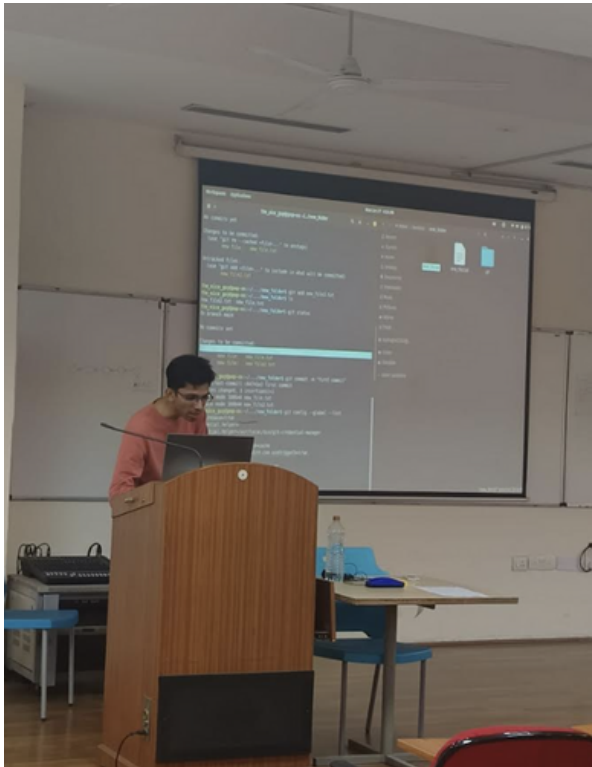

Certified Gitophile Workshop - URC

(27th January 2025)

IIIT-Delhi students delved into the world of version control with the Certified Gitophile Workshop, an engaging session on Git and GitHub conducted by URC. The workshop provided hands-on experience, guiding participants through essential concepts like repository management, commits, branching, and collaboration workflows.

Students actively practiced branching and merging strategies, explored remote repository management, and gained confidence in using GitHub for seamless teamwork.

Through step-by-step exercises, they strengthened their understanding of version control, preparing them for efficient project management.

The session equipped attendees with valuable skills for collaborative coding and software development, making it a truly enriching experience!

Spectroscopy Workshop - Astronuts

Participants navigated through multiple competitive rounds, including:

- Online Registration & Shortlisting – Over 100 students (60 teams) registered, with 20 teams advancing to the final round.
- Final Pitch Round – 16 teams presented their ideas to a prestigious Shark panel, including:
 1. Dr. Pravesh Biyani – Founder, Chartr App; Professor, IIIT Delhi.
 2. Mr. Mukul Chhabra – Founder, ScrapUncle; Shark Tank India S2 participant.
 3. Mr. Ehraz Imam – CTO, Enord.
- Evaluation Criteria – Pitches were judged on innovation, scalability, DPI impact, business viability, and presentation.

The event was a resounding success, equipping students with real-world entrepreneurial insights, valuable mentorship, and an unforgettable experience in startup pitching!



Inclusive Innovation Sprint - GirlUp x DDC'25

(17th February 2025)

GirlUp Udaan hosted the Inclusive Innovation Sprint, a design hackathon centered on accessibility and inclusivity in DPI. Participants engaged in a dynamic series of challenges, fostering innovation through interactive rounds:

- Blind Trading Round – Teams selected themes and strategically traded resources.
