


Python In MultiVerse

Women in Tech Hosts Insightful Session on Google's STEP Internship Program


(14th November, 2024)


Student Mentorship Program (SMP)

Unleashing creativity this Vigilance Week


(October 30 to November 2)

The participation at Surge provided the players with valuable competitive experience and strengthened their team spirit, reflecting IIIT-Delhi's commitment to fostering talent in sports.


Food Walk with Salt n' Pepper (23 November 2024)
