IIIT-Delhi Moves Into Its Own Campus



Since 2008, IIIT-Delhi had been operating out of its transit campus, at Netaji Subhas Institute of Technology. In August 2012, it shifted to its permanent campus in Okhla. The campus has a contemporary design and has facilities for research and teaching. [Read more](#)

High Quality Faculty



IIIT-Delhi has attracted over 26 faculty members, all of whom have Ph.D. degrees from some of the most reputed institutions of India and abroad including Boston University, Cardiff University, CMU, IISc, IIT's, ISI, NCU, Ohio State University, Technische Universitat Munchen, UCLA, USF, WSU and West Virginia University. IIIT-Delhi perhaps has the highest percentage of faculty with Ph.D's from universities in US and Europe. [Read more](#)

Academic Programs and Students



IIIT-Delhi offers B.Tech., M.Tech. and Ph.D. in CSE and ECE. The Under Graduate programs include B.Tech in CSE and ECE. The Institute has 425 students enrolled for B.Tech.(CSE), 100 in M.Tech. and 35 for Ph.D. This years intake of 120 students for B.Tech.(CSE) makes it the largest amongst computer science programs in most IIT's. Research Grants and Fellowships



In the last three years, several faculty members have received grants from DRDO, DST, MSR, Nokia Research Centre and won awards such as the Google Faculty Award and the IBM Faculty Award. Last year faculty members received research grants totaling Rs 2.5 Crores. 13 PhD students have received fellowships such as from TCS, IBM, Google and Microsoft Research India. [Read more](#)

Despite no past record, technology companies like Adobe, Microsoft, IBM, PayPal and more have recruited students of the first graduating batch of B.Tech(CSE) and M.Tech.(CSE).
