

Plagiarism & Cheating Policy for the placement process of IIT Delhi Students:

To ensure a fair and credible recruitment process, all students must strictly adhere to the following policy during placement assessments (online & offline in campus sort out of campus) conducted by visiting companies:

Strictly Prohibited Actions:

1. Use of Unauthorized Aids:
 - No use of mobile phones, smartwatches, laptops, tablets, calculators, or any electronic device.
 - No access to the internet, AI tools (e.g., ChatGPT), or any external software/platforms during the test.
2. Impersonation/Proxy:
 - No other individual is allowed to take the test or give an interview in place of the shortlisted student.
 - Any form of impersonation or proxy participation will lead to immediate disqualification and blacklisting.
3. Collaboration/External Help:
 - No discussion or collaboration with friends, classmates, or any third party—either in person or online.
4. Copying/Plagiarism:
 - Submitting copied answers from online sources or other candidates is strictly prohibited.
 - Even partial copying will be considered a serious violation.
5. Submission of False Documents or Information:
 - Providing incorrect or tampered academic records, resumes, certificates, or any other official documents is strictly forbidden.
 - Misrepresentation of CGPA or academic performance will be considered a major disciplinary offense.

Consequences of Violation:

- Immediate disqualification from the placement process if the concerned company or the invigilators inform the office about any of the above actions done by student/s.
- All such students will be debarred from the complete placement cycle.
- The placement Official will report the case to the disciplinary committee.

This policy is non-negotiable and will be strictly enforced. Students are expected to maintain integrity and uphold the reputation of the institution.
