

Call for 6-month Internships

Every public service we take for granted, appreciate, or criticize typically relies on a digital system behind the scenes. Whether you dial '112' during an emergency, receive a speeding ticket, or when the government plans rural road upgrades, provides financial assistance to women's groups, offers free health insurance to senior citizens, or grants scholarships, technology underpins these processes, and often goes unnoticed unless it fails.

These mission-critical systems demand highly skilled technologists who understand the realities of public service, policy, and the unique challenges of implementing tech solutions within complex social frameworks.

The Build for Bharat fellowship, a joint effort of CHCC, IIIT-Delhi, and Bharat Digital, aims to identify and train early-career public technologists who can strengthen, modernize, and humanize the digital technologies used to address India's most urgent public and governance challenges.

Work on real-world impactful projects, get training to be a public technologist, and receive mentorship from industry experts.

Stipend: 40,000 per month (Jan-June 2026)

Eligibility: Open to students (Bachelors/Masters/PhD) graduating in 2026 and graduates from the classes of 2024 and 2025.
