1	Product list for Tomato sauces or any other material	Tops/Kissan/Veeba Branded AGMARK/FSSAI /approved Quality makes to be used only
2	Sweet corn	Fresh /Tops/ Branded AGMARK/FSSAI /approved Quality makes to be used only
3	Breakfast menu Eggs meaning	Includes 2 eggs /student
4.	Utility billing	Includes electricity, water, PNG as per actual consumption billing for kitchens and maintenance charges are fixed for external mess cum services areas excluding kitchen, table chairs and kitchen equipment.
5	Maintenance	Kitchen hygiene and maintenance, equipment and its maintenance whether issued by IIITD/their own shall be responsibility of the mess vendor.
6	Rates	Rates of items in tender are the revised rates and shall be fixed for two years. Subsequently change in rates possible after Student mess committee and Eatery Committee recommendations.
7	Coupons issued	Directly by a mess vendor who maintains records after online payment. However, the institute reserves the right to change/modify the coupon related policy.
8	Equipment and AMC	The equipment, plates etc provided by the IIITD are ready for inspection and will be made available as is where is condition. No AMC of the equipment are available as yet.
9	Academic schedule and breaks	There are 3 months break in Summer (May-July) and 1 month in Winter (Dec) which are not covered by the semester month coupons. Those staying back will pay and eat during the period at any time. The 8 month coupons stand with a minimum guarantee of 400 (as per the tender terms) students only.
10	Peak student capacity and likely footfall	There would be around 1000 students eating at the first and second floor mess. Increase in footfall beyond 400 will depend on the quality of the food served on the menu etc. No exact working of footfall is feasible with conditions in the pandemic/ global situations.
